
#### Hey there, Rock Star!

#### Some supplies to have handy for Selling:

#### STANDARD TAGGING SUPPLIES:

- Computer or mobile device
- Printer\*
- White \*\* card stock (60lb+)

\*\*Please do not use any color card stock other than white.

- 1.5 2.0 inch safety pins
- Child-sized plastic or wire hangers
- Gallon & quart clear ziplock bags
- XL Ziploc/storage bags (Dollar Store!)
- Clear packing tape
- Painters/masking tape
- Scissors
- Ribbon, string or zip-ties

#### \*No Printer? No Problem!

#### **OPTIONAL SUPPLIES:**

- Tagging gun & barbs
- Paper cutter
- Cleaning supplies such as Magic Eraser, stain remover, bleach pen, wrinkle releaser and odor remover—all are helpful!

When you finish creating your tags, use the "Print PDF" option and save the PDF file. Printing your tags at an office supply store will save you ink and time. Don't forget to ask them to cut your tags!

### Look everywhere! Clear out, Ca\$h in.

#### **Attic or Basement:**

Clothing stored in tubs, larger items such as children's furniture, mattresses, baby gear and other bulky items like pack 'n plays, bassinets and exersaucers.

#### Kid's Bedroom:

Clothing, shoes, accessories - belts, ties, tights, and socks. Area rugs, picture frames, lamps, wall hangings and other decorative items. From the the nurseryglider and foot stool, boppy, baby monitor, infant carrier, humidifier and crib toys.

#### Living Room:

DVDs, gaming systems, & video games.

#### Linen Closet:

Crib sheets, hooded towels, character beach towels, washcloths & cloth diapers.

#### Bathroom:

Potty seats, Diaper Genies, wipe warmers, outgrown (new) disposable diapers, cloth diapers, infant tubs, bath seats, bath toys, & step stools.

#### Mom's Closet:

Best maternity wear, nursing bras, nursing PJ's & pillows.

#### Mud Room or Hall Closet:

Gear for outside play...including the pool!

#### Kitchen:

Children's utensils, dishes, sippy cups, bottles, lunch boxes, high chair, Bumbo & booster seat.

#### Playroom:

Games, puzzles, books, toys, arts and crafts and dress-up items.

#### Garage:

Ride-on toys, car seats, scooters, trikes, bikes, bike helmets, sports equipment including cleats, & don't forget strollers!

#### Outside:

Slides, playhouse, car seat, swing & sandbox.

#### Have a stack of items ready? Great! Grab 3 totes, baskets, or boxes and let's sort.

These are items you are not quite ready to let go of just yet. That's perfectly fine! We all keep a few treasures.

#### Items sell best when they meet the 4 C's:


- **Clean:** The newer it looks, the better it sells! Check carefully for stains, holes, rips, tears to make sure items are clean & stain free, fresh, and in good condition.
- **Current:** Sell clothing, shoes, and items in the correct season—warm weather items at the SPRING event, cool weather clothing at FALL event. Shoppers are looking for current styles and fashion!
- **Complete:** toys, games and puzzles must be sold as a complete set.
- **Compliant:** Check important safety guidelines on <u>www.jbfsale.com</u>. Let's help keep all our children and families safe.



TOSS



Ah yes. We all know there is such a thing as too well loved. These items have stains, holes, rips, tears, missing pieces. These items can be recycled or donated.





### Prep: Grab Tags & Supplies

Following is what you need to know about attaching tags, packaging non-clothing items, and hanging clothes like a PRO! Here is a <u>Quick Reference Guide</u> that summarizes everything.



Start with your biggest selling items FIRST to insure that you will make a good return on your time. Separating items by size and category will help too.



### Prep: Toys & Gear

Getting these items as clean as you can will help them SELL. A Magic Eraser and some elbow grease go a long way.

Also, check to make sure there are no recalls for these items here. Attach your tag to the item with clear tape or punch a hole in the tag and fasten with a ziptie—whichever will secure the tag in a visible location.

### **Prep: Clothing**

Make sure your items are clean, stain free—and smell good!

A squirt of fabric refresher can go a long way. Using Downy Wrinkle Release, too, will help smooth items—or, you can toss them in the dryer to help get wrinkles out too.

- Grab a hanger and hang your item with the hanger making a question mark.
- Pin or attach your JBF tag to the item's tag or at a seam.
- For items like socks or tights, bag them together and tape your tag to the bag using clear tape.

### Prep: Using a Tagging Gun



Tagging guns are AWESOME! BUT make sure you secure the tag **at a seam** so the item will not have a hole in it.



You may want to test this out on an old item you don't plan to sell to make sure you hone your tagging gun skills first.

<u>Here</u> is a quick Dos & Don't When Using a Tagging Gun!



### **Prep: Multi-Piece Clothing**

Position both items on one hanger so you can pin them together as a set.

Sets sell well at our sale! Just make sure the items are secured to the hanger.

Pin the tag so you can see that all items are present. Make note on the tag that this is a multi-piece set. You only need one tag if selling a set.



### Prep: Bags & Carriers



Hole punch your tags and zip-tie to your bag or carrier. Use pins to secure your bag to a hanger. Make sure the tag is visible.

Also check all the pockets—you don't want to leave anything valuable in them!



Hole-punch your tag and use a zip-tie to secure both shoes and tag together.

Shoes must be in great condition. Magic Erasers take off scuffs and help shoes (and other items) sell!





### Prep: Books & DVDs



Use clear bags or clear cling wrap to hold multiple items together. Tie sets of books together.

Use clear tape to attach tags to items. Use painter's tape if removing tape will damage your item.

Do not tape DVDs closed (we will add a security sticker after Drop Off).



#### **Prep: Book Sets**



Use clear bags to keep book sets together. Tape your tag to the outside of your bag. Make sure your tag includes all the books that are part of the set.



#### Prep: Keep it Safe!



One of the great things about our sale is that Just Between Friends is the only event in the industry to employ a safety and recall specialist! We work to keep families safe.

Please check <u>our website</u> to make sure ALL your items are safe to sell.



### Prep: Selling a Car Seat or Crib?



Make sure you print and sign our WAIVER and bring that with you to the sale!

### Pricing: You set your price.



Now that you have a stack of items you want to SELL, it's time to PRICE them.

So, how to price?





### Be shopper-focused.

Ask, "What price would make me buy this item without a second thought...and then brag about my bargain to my friends?"

### Pricing: Create your tags

Now that you've thought about your pricing, grab your items and log into your JBF profile on the website. Click the TAGGING button at the top of the page.








### Pricing: Enter your tags


- Select "Create Tags" to get started.
- Choose the SEASON (Spring/Summer or Fall/Winter).
- Choose the category and size of your item.
- Enter a detailed description and set your price.





### **Pricing: Select Preferences**

- Select (click box) if you want to:
  - REDUCE: items will go half off on final sale day
  - DONATE: Clicking this box means unsold items will go to local charities AFTER the event if they do not sell. This is a tax deductible donation.





### Pricing: Talk-to-Text TIP!

• Use your smart phone's talk-to-text function to enter tags even faster!








### Pricing: Print your Tags



PRINT your tags on <u>white</u> cardstock. We love to use the **9 tags per page** PDF option. After you cut out your tags, organize them by type & size. This will make your next step faster!

### Step 5: DROP OFF







### Drop Off: Pack it up, drop it off.



Now that you've priced, tagged, and prepped, you're ready to drop off!



Keep items organized by size and type to speed things up during the drop off process. Things have a way of shifting around in transit! A few rubber bands can help keep hangers together in the car!



### Drop Off: Pack up, drop off.



Shawnee/Kansas City Location: Wyandotte County Fairgrounds (Big Red Barn) Address: 13700 Polfer Road, KC, KS Dates/Times: Mon, March 30<sup>th</sup> from 6pm-8pm & Tues, March 31<sup>st</sup> from 9am-8pm

#### **Overland Park**

Location: Overland Park Convention Center Address: 6000 College Blvd, OP, KS Dates/Times: Mon, May 11<sup>th</sup> from 6pm-8pm & Tues, May 12<sup>th</sup> 9am-8pm.

- Brings your items during drop off times. No need to make an appointment, just come when it's convenient for you.
- You will check in at our consignor check-in desk and turn in your waivers and consignor agreement (which will be sent to you electronically shortly before the event).



#### Drop Off: What to expect



Once you've checked in, you will place your items on the sales floor.

Items will be grouped by type (toys go together, books, etc.). You will hang your clothing by gender and size and behind a lettered plate that corresponds to your consignor number.

It's easy to do and the typical consignor can be done in 45 minutes or less, depending on the number of items you are bringing.

#### Other good stuff to know:



- You can check you're MY JBF TAGS site to see which items have sold in real time during the sale.
- Your check will arrive electronically in your inbox within 2 weeks after the sales event closes!

#### PRESALE SHOPPING PASS!

- You will receive your presale pass via email once drop off has completed.
- As a consignor, you are have earned this perk, so plan to shop early—and bring a friend to shop the BEST DEALS!

#### **SHOP EARLY TIMES:**

- Shawnee/Kansas City
  - Wed, April 1<sup>st</sup> | 1pm
  - 50% Off Presale Sat, April 4<sup>th</sup>|5pm
- Overland Park
  - Wed, May 13<sup>th</sup>|12pm
  - 50% Off Presale Sat, May 16<sup>th</sup> | 5pm

\*Note that the times above are the time you can start shopping – you may come anytime after these times!

### Picking up Unsold Items?

If you want to PICK UP unsold items (meaning, you chose not to donate unsold items), note that PICK UP is: Shawnee/Kansas City ~ Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 5pm-7pm Overland Park ~ Monday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, 5pm-7pm

After this time, all items, without exception, will be donated to our charity partner. **Please Note:** If you choose the **donate option** when creating your tags, your items will be pulled and donated on your behalf at the conclusion of the sale prior to our sorting process. Once you have dropped your items off at the sale, this option cannot be undone. If you choose to donate your unsold items, you do not need to worry about picking up!
